EQUIP ACADEMY (EA) provides short-term (4-12 week) courses designed to provide foundational Biblical and practical training to help Living Hope disciples apply the gospel in order to live hopeful and be helpful, both in the church and in the world.

EA training is not reserved for the spiritually elite or Bible scholars. It is for stay-at-home moms, senior adults, men and women of all generations, deacons, Connect Group shepherds, businessmen and women, marrieds and singles – anyone who wants to grow stronger as a disciple of Jesus and a leader in His kingdom.

COURSES: Nearly thirty **EA** courses are arranged in four tracks that correspond to growth needs of disciples and leaders: *Disciple Basics, Foundations, Shepherding, and Kingdom Leadership*. Courses are offered on a rotating cycle, so that most will be offered a couple of times every two years. The complete **EA** catalog with course descriptions is available at livehopeful.com.

RESOURCES: Courses will be free of charge, except for needed books or optional resources, which will be available at discounted rates when the class meets.

We will also offer a limited number of additional Bible studies each session on an a la carte basis.
