Monday: Local and Global Impact

- Pray this Scripture for them: **Mark 4:30–32** And he said, "With what can we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable shall we use for it? ³¹ It is like a grain of mustard seed, which, when sown on the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on earth, ³² yet when it is sown it grows up and becomes larger than all the garden plants and puts out large branches, so that the birds of the air can make nests in its shade."
- Pray God will bless them with faith and that faith will transform them and grow in them.
- Contact them, if you can, and let them know you are praying for them and find out how they are doing.

Thursday: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray for families in our community.

- Pray that husbands and wives will love one another and honor the vows they made to each other.
- Pray the children will be taught to love Jesus at home and will love the church and remain faithful to a church family all the days of their lives.
- Pray that students and young adults will be sexually pure and honor God with their bodies.
- Pray that families will grow in the faith together and live on mission where they live.
- Pray that our families will live with hope be a help to those in our city living in sin and darkness.

Friday: Prayer Walk your home, school, work, or hangout.

Focus on the Scripture: **Galatians 1:3–5** Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, ⁴ who gave himself for our sins to deliver us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, ⁵ to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen.

- Pray that they will know God's grace and peace found in Christ alone.
- Pray they will become free from sin and live to glorify God in His love.
- Ask God to make you a conduit of His grace and enable you to bring those around you to saving faith in Christ and then to become a part of our church family.

Saturday: Pray for Sunday's Worship Gatherings

We will continue in our summer series: "Rooted!" We will look at what happened when Peter and the other apostles were persecuted for their faith and how it is we can trust and honor God in times of suffering.
