Monday: Local and Global Impact Partners

Today's focus is on two of our global partners.

Wes and Leah Brooks

- **Praise and Prayer** – Wes & Leah attended Urbana18 Missions Conference. They talked with 400 students and shared several times about Digital Missions and opportunities for internships/work with Cru. Give praise for the many contacts made. Pray that more students and young professionals will gain a heart for using their skills in digital missions in the coming months!
- **Prayer** - Continue praying for more people to join their teams! While they had some great conversations with people at Urbana, no easy, immediate opportunities presented themselves. Please pray for resolutions to roadblocks and that the Lord will move in people's hearts to jump on board with them!
- **Praise** - After a year of a significant travel in 2018, they're set to be home in Orlando for some time. Praise God for all He accomplished through their adventures last year, but it's really great for them to get some time back at home base and digging in to their day-to-day roles.

Seth Stewart (Christian Student Fellowship – CSF)

- Pray for new students being invited and welcomed at CSF. Especially at the beginning of the semester, CSF has lots of new students coming to programs and CSF wants to welcome them and invite them into our community.
- Pray for the student Leaders: CSF has over 100 student leaders that do everything from leading groups to making food for the various events. I always pray that God will continue growing them and pouring into their lives as they serve in the ministry

- Pray for the hearts of clients and their families to be open to the gospel, *“that they may turn from the darkness to light and from the power of satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.” Acts 26:17b-18*

Wednesday: Revival in the church, city, and nation.

Focus your prayer around: **1 Timothy 6:2-4** *“Teach and urge these things. ³ If anyone teaches a different doctrine and does not agree with the sound words of our Lord Jesus Christ and the teaching that accords with godliness, ⁴ he is puffed up with conceit and understands nothing.”*

- Pray that we will maintain biblically-sound doctrine within the church.
- Pray that we have confidence in the Word of God.
- Pray that we have unity to believe what the Bible says.
- Pray that we see people saved who pursue growth in Christ with sound doctrine.

Thursday: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray that our city will experience a revival.

- Pray that all Bible-preaching churches experience a great movement of God's Spirit.
- Pray that our city sees many people saved radically.
- Pray that we will see people gathering and praying fervently.
- Pray that God will use our church and city to help many know Jesus Christ here and in the world.

Friday: Prayer Walk your home, school, work, or hangout.

Focus your prayer around: **1 Timothy 6:12** *“Fight the good fight of the faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called and about which you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.”*

- Pray for great grace to be on you and all those you come into contact with.
- Pray for yourself and others to see God bring about spiritual transformation.
- Pray for yourself and others to have a salvation testimony and the love and faith to share it.

Saturday: Pray for Sunday’s Worship Gatherings

This Sunday, we continue our series: **DIVINE PURPOSE**. We will talk about how gratitude and prayers have divine purpose. Our focus text is **Colossians 1:3-5a**. The Main Thrust is to challenge the church to be thankful and prayerful so we are strengthened to accomplish God’s purpose.

- Pray for people to gather for worship and to delight in praising and giving to God.
- Ask God to reveal to you His divine purpose and how you are to live it out in the church and as the church.
