January 28-February 2, 2019

Monday: Local and Global Impact Partners

Today's focus is our global partners: **Ross and Natalie - East Asia**

- Please pray for a new believer, who we call Reeder. They first met Reeder with a team from Living Hope. Last Sunday, Reeder was baptized! Pray for his continued boldness and that he will stand firm amid likely persecution.
- Ross & Natalie are currently in the middle of celebrating the Lunar New Year. This is a time when everyone travels back to their hometowns or villages for a couple of weeks. Pray for open hearts and much Holy Spirit conviction as Ross & Natalie travel to villages and share their faith.

Tuesday: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

- Pray for the for those who come to the Hope Center for Biblical Counseling. Pray they will call upon God, the Father of mercies, compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts them in their times of troubles, so that their counselors can comfort those in any trouble which they also receive comfort from God. **2 Corinthians 1:3-4**
- Pray God will give the wisdom to volunteers when engaging with the women who come into the Hope Center for Pregnancy. Pray they know and understand that *"the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere."* **James 3:17**

Wednesday: Revival in the church, city, and nation.

Focus your prayer around: **John 3:3** *"Jesus answered him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God."*

- Pray that the Spirit of God will bring deep conviction on lost people to be saved and for Christians to be sanctified.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will speak mightily through our pastors as they preach and that God would give us ears that can hear and eyes that can see the truth.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will move mightily in our worship and transform our lives.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will guide our members to seek to hear people's stories of how they have or have not lived with Jesus and to help us share our story of how Jesus' grace transformed us.

Thursday: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray that our nation, beginning with our leaders, will humble itself.

- Pray that there will be a desire to serve others and show love rather than argue with others and be hateful.
- Pray that our leaders will put aside their pride and work together for the good of the nation.
- Pray that people will be humbled by God's goodness and grateful for our blessings.
- Pray that people will understand the Gospel and humbly receive Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

Friday: Prayer Walk your home, school, work, or hangout.

Focus your prayer around: **John 3:30** *"He must increase, but I must decrease."*

- Pray for a desire to serve those around you.
- Pray those around you hunger and thirst for Jesus in their life.
- Pray for a willingness to take the time to listen and get to know those around you and listen to their stories and needs.

Saturday: Pray for Sunday's Worship Gatherings

This Sunday, we continue our series: DIVINE PURPOSE. We will talk about how **Faith and Friends have Divine Purpose**. Our focus text is **Colossians 1:5b-8**. The Main Thrust is to challenge the church to believe that faith in the Gospel and love for the saints are fundamental to God's divine purpose.

- Pray for people to gather for worship and to delight in praising and giving to God.
- Ask God to reveal to you His divine purpose and how you are to live it out in the church and as the church.
- Pray that many guests will come and hear the Gospel and be saved.
- Pray that many that have drifted from the Lord will renew their walk with Jesus and get connected in the life of Living Hope.
- Pray that our times of praise honor God and renew our hope in the Gospel.
