Monday: Local and Global Impact Partners

Today's focus is our local partners.

- **Pray for our Chinese Fellowship** – Chinese New Year, The largest outreach service of the year, is planned for February 8 beginning at 6p in the Student Center. The gospel will be shared to students, Confucius Institute teachers, and other members of the Chinese community. Pray many come to saving faith during this important festival.
- **Pray for the Hope House Ministries** –
 - The Winter session of Jobs for Life began a week ago. This program teaches individuals how to get jobs.
 - Faith and Finances begins Feb 21. This program teaches people how to apply Biblical principles to their financial management.
 - Raising Highly Capable Kids begins Feb 21. This program teaches parents how to apply Biblical principles.
 - Of course, a big part of these classes is hearing the gospel and applying it to their entire lives. Please pray for many to place their faith in Jesus during these classes. Please pray that individuals enrolled in these classes will apply the Biblical principles into their own lives.
- **Pray for Refuge Bowling Green** – Connecting churches to refugees, Refuge Bowling Green has launched and is submerged into the ministry for refugees in our city and county. Tuesday: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

- Pray for those who come to the Hope Center for Biblical Counseling. Focus your prayer around: **John 10:10** *The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.*

- Pray that the Spirit of God will bring deep conviction on lost people to be saved and for Christians to be sanctified.
- Pray that people will see the world, the flesh, and the devil for what they are and trust in Jesus.
- Pray that people will be set free from the lies of the world, the flesh, and the devil.
- Pray that many will receive the abundant life that comes through Christ alone.

Thursday: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray that God will lead hundreds of women to the Pregnancy Center and many will be saved.

- Pray that God will supernaturally move people to go to the Pregnancy Center.
- Pray that the ladies and their family will hear the Gospel and be saved and become disciples of Jesus at Living Hope.
- Pray that hundreds of babies will be saved and cared for.
- Pray that the leaders will not grow weary in doing good.

Friday: Prayer Walk your home, school, work, or hangout.

Focus your prayer around: **John 10:14** *“I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me,”*

- Pray you will be led by Jesus and follow His lead in helping others with hope.
- Pray those around you hunger and thirst for Jesus in their life.
- Pray for a willingness to take the time to listen and get to know those around you and listen to their stories and needs.

Saturday: Pray for Sunday’s Worship Gatherings

This Sunday, we continue our series: DIVINE PURPOSE. We will talk about how **God’s Will and Good Works have Divine Purpose**. Our focus text is **Colossians 1:9-10**. The Main Thrust is to challenge the church to believe that God is at work in the world and that we get to join Him in accomplishing His divine purpose in others and in us.

- Pray for people to gather for worship and to delight in praising and giving to God.
- Ask God to reveal to you His divine purpose and how you are to live it out in the church and as the church.
