

Monday: Local and Global Impact Partners

Today's focus is our Local Impact ministries:

- **Pray for our Fruit** – There have been many outreach initiatives this past month including, outreach to the Kentucky State Police, hospital staffs, hospital waiting rooms, Warren County Parks and Rec, Chinese community (Chinese New Year), Hope House, and many more. Please pray for fruit for the Kingdom from the many acts of service in Jesus' name and the many conversations encouraging people to place their faith in Jesus.
- **Pray for Redeemer Outreach Easter Egg Hunt** – Last year, hundreds of people attended Redeemer Campus Easter Egg Hunt. This is a great opportunity to point attendees to the hope they can have through the Gospel. Please pray for many to come to faith in Jesus during this huge outreach in April.
- **Pray for Living Hope's Gospel Work in the Warren Central Area** – There are a growing number of opportunities to bring the gospel to the area of our city between Morgantown and Glen Lilly Roads. Prayer is key as we consider ways to engage people with the gospel. Please pray for teams as we launch block parties and individual ministries, such as (potentially) ESL and tutoring to people living in that densely populated area.
- **Pray for Curbside Ministries** – Curbside Ministries is resuming their outreach to the Parker-Bennett School area of Bowling Green this month. There are many children who come to be fed with a message about Jesus and food. This is a vital outreach to engage that community with the gospel. The second location of Curbside's ministry will resume soon as the weather becomes favorable to outdoor activities. That location is Lee Street. Hundreds of kids attend that location's outreach. Please pray for fruit of salvation and discipleship for that ministry as Terri Sheldon and her team strives to make disciples in our city.

Tuesday: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

- Pray for those who come to the Hope Center for Biblical Counseling. Pray they will see God doing more than they could ever ask or imagine according to His power that is at work within us. **Ephesians 3:20** *"Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us."*
- Pray the Advocates and Volunteers in the Hope Center for Pregnancy will trust in the Lord with all their hearts and not lean on their own understanding. Pray that they will acknowledge Him and trust that He will make their paths straight in each step of their training and service. **Proverbs 3:4-5**

Wednesday: Revival in the church, city, and nation.

Focus your prayer around: **Luke 12:20-21** *"But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul is required of you, and the things you have prepared, whose will they be?'²¹ So is the one who lays up treasure for himself and is not rich toward God."*

- Pray that the Spirit of God will bring deep concern in Living Hope for people who are now on their way to hell. Pray we will do, give, share, and pray all we can so people will be saved.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will convict people of their sin and that they will repent and believe and live their lives under the authority of Jesus.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will move mightily in our worship and transform our lives.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will guide our members to seek and hear people's stories of how they have or have not lived with Jesus and to help us share our story of how Jesus' grace transformed us.

Thursday: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray that our city will honor the will of God in His design and acknowledge the innate value of every human being. We have been made in God's image to honor God by living and acknowledging God's sovereign plan for making men to be men and women to be women.

- Pray that there will be laws that protect lives and the dignity of all people.
- Pray that our leaders will not create laws that go against God's creative purpose for human beings made as either a man or a woman.
- Pray that people will be humbled by God's goodness and grateful for our blessings.
- Pray that people will understand the Gospel and humbly receive Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

Friday: Prayer Walk your home, school, work, or hangout.

Focus your prayer around: **Luke 12:22** *"And he said to his disciples, 'Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat, nor about your body, what you will put on.'"*

- Pray that you can trust God.
- Pray that you will be a person of prayer who looks to God in faith and asks Him to provide.
- Pray for a grateful heart that praises God for His provision and plans.

Saturday: Pray for Sunday's Worship Gatherings

This Sunday, we continue our series: **DIVINE PERSPECTIVE**. We will talk about how **Jesus Is the Maker and Maintainer of Everything**. Our focus text is **Colossians 1:16-17**. The Main Thrust is that Jesus made all that is and holds it together by His might and yet loves us (Ps 8:4) and is accomplishing His will in our lives and in the world.

- Pray for people to gather for worship and to delight in praising and giving to God.
- Ask God to reveal to you His divine purpose and how you are to live it out in the church and as the church.
- Pray that many guests will come and hear the Gospel and be saved.
- Pray that many that have drifted from the Lord will renew their walk with Jesus and get connected in the life of Living Hope.
- Pray that our times of praise honor God and renew our hope in the Gospel.
