

**Monday: Local and Global Impact Partners**

Today's focus is Jacob and Cara (Portugal).

- This month a new church plant in Senhora da Hora\* will start to meet regularly. Pray for doors to open as they seek a location and for people in the community to be interested.
- Over the last month, Jacob & Laura have been encouraged as they've been able to start several discipleship relationships with young people. Pray that they will spur growth and see the younger generation rise up in Biblical literacy and discipleship.

**Tuesday: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center**

- Pray for the Hope Center for Biblical Counseling. Pray that the community will find a place of refuge, a place where they encounter the Lord and experience His protection. *"But let all who take refuge in you rejoice; let them ever sing for joy, and spread your protection over them, that those who love your name may exalt you. For you bless the righteous, O Lord; you cover them with favor as with a shield."* **Psalm 5:11-12**
- Pray for the women who will come into the Hope Center for Pregnancy or those who are struggling now with their past. Pray they will know the Lord's great love and mercy. Pray they will receive the Lord's forgiveness of their past sins and rebellious ways, knowing that the Lord is good. *"Remember, O Lord, your great mercy and love, for they are from of old. Remember not the sins of my youth and my rebellious ways; according to your love remember me, for you are good, O Lord."* **Psalm 25:6-7**

**Wednesday: Revival in the church, city, and nation.**

Focus your prayer around: **Romans 10:14-15** *"How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? <sup>15</sup> And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!"*

- Pray that we will have many from Living Hope sharing the Good News at work, school, and wherever we are this week.
- Pray specifically for people you know who need to take a step toward God. Ask God to use you to reach them, share your hope, and help them.
- Pray that Living Hope will be a healthy family of disciples who make disciples. Ask God to give us a heart for the broken and complete confidence in His power in the Gospel.

**Thursday: A need in our city, nation, or world**

**Romans 10:3** *"For, being ignorant of the righteousness of God, and seeking to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness."*

- Pray that God will call our leaders to repent and to seek His righteous ways.
- Pray that the nation will rise up and seek God and experience radical revival.
- Pray that the city of Bowling Green will be led by Godly people who seek to honor God according to the law of God and submit to God's righteousness and not human affections.

**Friday: Prayer Walk your home, school, work, or hangout.**

Focus your prayer around: **Mark 10:9** *"What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate."*

- Pray you will experience a healthy marriage.
- Pray for those you know who are married to keep their vows and honor God in their marriage.
- Pray for those who are suffering from the pain of divorce to seek and find help in the church and through the Counseling Center at Living Hope.

**Saturday: Pray for Sunday's Worship Gatherings**

This Sunday, we continue our series: DIVINE PURPOSE. We will talk about how **Deliverance and Dominion have Divine Purpose**. Our focus text is **Colossians 1:13-14**. The Main Thrust is to believe that God has a purpose for freeing us and also for His Kingdom and the kingdom of darkness.

- Pray that many will be delivered from sin and begin to live in the light of God's love.
- Ask God to reveal to you how you can best live in the freedom Christ has given to us.
- Pray that many guests will come and hear the Gospel and be saved.
- Pray that many that have drifted from the Lord will renew their walk with Jesus and get connected in the life of Living Hope.
- Pray that our times of praise honor God and renew our hope in the Gospel.
