

**Monday: Local and Global Impact Partners**

Today's focus is on our Global Partners: **Mark and Parker Phillips**. Here are their requests:

- Please pray for their security situation in Niger. Their ability to travel outside of Niamey seems to grow smaller each week. Over 60% of the villages they have worked in are no longer accessible. Pray that Mark & Parker have wise courage in the face of these challenges.
- Please pray for 20 church leaders representing 5 people groups and 15 villages who received training last week. With their cultural knowledge and because of the security concerns, Mark & Parker will be relying on these men to reproduce this training in areas they can no longer access. Pray for them to faithfully reproduce their training so that more might be equipped for ministry.

**Tuesday: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center**

- Pray that those who come to the Hope Center for Biblical Counseling will be reminded or will come to know of God's steadfast love for them. Pray that, ultimately, their hearts will come to be satisfied and filled with God's love for them. *"Let them thank the Lord for his steadfast love, for his wondrous works to the children of man! For he satisfies the longing soul, and the hungry soul he fills with good things."* **Psalm 107:8-9**
- Pray for the ladies who have experienced an abortion in their lives, and women who have never talked about their abortion or received healing from the Lord. Pray those women will know that only God can offer the restoration they seek. Pray they will cry out to the Lord, knowing God will lift them out of the pit and place their feet on the rock; placing a new song in their mouth and they trust in the Lord. **Psalm 40:1-3**

**Wednesday: Revival in the church, city, and nation.**

Focus your prayer around: **Exodus 3:7-8** *"Then the LORD said, 'I have surely seen the affliction of my people who are in Egypt and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters. I know their sufferings, and I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land to a good and broad land, a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Amorites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites.'*"

- Pray that God will see the affliction and brokenness of our land and hear our cries and come down and deliver millions from sin and death.
- Pray specifically for people you know who need to take a step toward God and ask God to use you to reach them and share your hope and help them.
- Pray that Living Hope will be a healthy family of disciples who make disciples. Ask God to give us a heart for the broken and complete confidence in His power in the Gospel.

**Thursday: A need in our city, nation, or world**

**1 Corinthians 5:1** *"It is actually reported that there is sexual immorality among you, and of a kind that is not tolerated even among pagans, for a man has his father's wife."*

- Pray that God will call His church to be faithful to the sexual ethic of the Bible: one man with one woman until death parts them.
- Pray that churches will protect children especially, but also all members as well from leaders who would sexually abuse them.
- Pray that Living Hope will hold our Biblical articles of faith and honor God. Pray we'll be a light in the darkness that points people to the hope of Jesus and the lifestyle of purity He produces.

**Friday: Prayer Walk your home, school, work, or hangout.**

Focus your prayer around: **1 Corinthians 6:1** *"When one of you has a grievance against another, does he dare go to law before the unrighteous instead of the saints?"*

- Pray for peace in your home, neighborhood, and the places you go each day/week.
- Pray for Living Hope to be a peacemaking people who live in peace. Pray we will help others know the peace that comes through grace and forgiveness.
- Pray for those who are suffering from conflicts in their relationships. Pray they are guided to follow God's commands to make peace and to pursue help from our counseling center, as needed.

**Saturday: Pray for Sunday's Worship Gatherings**

This Sunday, we begin a new series: *Divine Perspective*. We will talk about how **Jesus Is Incomprehensibly Comprehensible**. Our focus text is **Colossians 1:15**. The Main Thrust is to believe that Jesus is God made manifest in man to man, but is fully God.

- Ask God to reveal to you how you can best live in awe of who Jesus is.
- Pray that many guests will come and hear the Gospel and be saved.
- Pray that many that have drifted from the Lord will renew their walk with Jesus and get connected in the life of Living Hope.
- Pray that our times of praise honor God and renew our hope in the Gospel.
