Pray that, as advocates share the truth of the Gospel, God will open the eyes, ears, and hearts of those who hear and they will, "confess with their mouths that Jesus is Lord and believe in their heart that God raised him from the dead," and they will be saved. **Romans 10:9**

**Wednesday: Revival in the church, city, and nation.**

Focus your prayer around: **2 Corinthians 5:10** *"For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil."*

- Pray that the Spirit of God will bring deep concern in Living Hope for people who are now on their way to hell and to do, give, share, and pray all we can so people will be saved.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will convict people of their sin and that they will repent and believe and live their lives under the authority of Jesus.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will move mightily in our worship and transform our lives.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will guide our members to seek to hear people's stories of how they have or have not lived with Jesus and to help us share our story of how Jesus' grace transformed us.

**Thursday: A need in our city, nation, or world**

Pray that Bible-believing Christians from all over Bowling Green will pray for revival and be faithful to share the love and hope of the Gospel with those in their workplace, school, and neighborhood.

- Pray that there will be people that pray more regularly for revival.
- Pray that pastors will be emboldened and strengthened to proclaim the Gospel.
- Pray that people will be humbled by God's goodness, grateful for our blessings, and share the love that God has shown to them.
- Pray that people will understand the Gospel and humbly receive Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

**Friday: Prayer Walk your home, school, work, or hangout.**

Focus your prayer around: **2 Corinthians 4:17-18** *"For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison,<sup>18</sup> as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal."*

- Pray that those around you can trust God in their challenges.
- Pray that you will be a person of prayer who is faithful to lift up those around you.
- Pray for a grateful heart that praises God for His provision and plans.

**Saturday: Pray for Sunday's Worship Gatherings**

This Sunday, we continue our series, **DIVINE PERSPECTIVE**. We will talk about how **Jesus Is the Ultimate Peacemaking Warrior**. Our focus text is **Colossians 1:18-20**. The Main Thrust is that Jesus is the leader of His church and has saved her by His power, which has resulted in eternal peace with God.

- Pray for people to gather for worship and to delight in praising and giving to God.
- Ask God to reveal to you His divine purpose and how you are to live it out in the church and as the church.
- Pray that many guests will come and hear the Gospel and be saved.
- Pray that many that have drifted from the Lord will renew their walk with Jesus and get connected in the life of Living Hope.
- Pray that our times of praise honor God and renew our hope in the Gospel.
