

Monday: Local and Global Impact Partners

Today's focus is on our Global Partners: **Jacob and Cara (Portugal)**

- Pray for the church plant, Oasis. They have recently secured a new meeting space. Pray that the people in the area will be receptive to the church plant and that people will be drawn to the Gospel.
- Praise for the success of the recent mission trip from Living Hope! The team worked to spread the Gospel to kids in the community, as well as in Senhora da Hora by sharing the Easter story. Praise for the encouragement that was provided throughout the trip. Pray for the seeds that were planted to take root and that more people will respond to the Gospel.

Tuesday: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

- Pray for the counselors in the Hope Center for Biblical Counseling. Pray they will fear the Lord and rely upon His wisdom. Pray they will live out the word to everyone they meet. *"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom; all those who practice it have a good understanding. His praise endures forever!" Psalm 111:10*
- Pray for the Hope Center for Pregnancy. Pray that all remember *"the steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness."* **Lamentations 3:22-23**

Wednesday: Revival in the church, city, and nation.

Focus your prayer around **Isaiah 6:1-5**:

"In the year that King Uzziah died I saw the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up; and the train of his robe filled the temple. ² Above him stood the seraphim. Each had six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. ³ And one called to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!" ⁴ And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him who called, and the house was filled with smoke. ⁵ And I said: "Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!"

1 Peter 1:15-16 *"but as he who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, ¹⁶ since it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy."*

- Pray that God will grant believers a deeper understanding and awareness of His holiness. Holiness is essential to revival. We need to understand that God is utterly holy.
- Pray that we will be gripped by the absolute holiness of God.

Thursday: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray for Easter services at Living Hope, in our city, and all around the world.

- Pray that we will be active in inviting people to attend Easter services at Living hope.
- Pray that many will come to saving faith, return to walking with Jesus, get involved at Living Hope, and experience the power of the resurrection.
- Pray that God is honored and glorified in all seven of our services.

Friday: Prayer Walk your home, school, work, or hangout.

Focus your prayer around: **John 20:8-9** *"Then the other disciple, who had reached the tomb first, also went in, and he saw and believed; ⁹ for as yet they did not understand the Scripture, that he must rise from the dead."*

- Pray that we will understand the Scriptures.
- Pray that our lost family members, friends, and neighbors will understand the Scriptures will be saved and/or revived to return to walking faithfully with Christ and His church.
- Pray that we will be active in listening to others and sharing our story with God's story.

Saturday: Pray for Sunday's Worship Gatherings

This Sunday, we celebrate Easter!

- Ask God to reveal to revive you and the entire church.
- Pray that many guests will come and hear the Gospel and be saved.
- Pray that many that have drifted from the Lord will renew their walk with Jesus and get connected in the life of Living Hope.
