DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that Living Hope would be committed to making true disciples of the next generation so that an awakening can occur.

You shall teach [God's commandments] diligently to your children. — Deut. 6:7

MONDAY: Global Impact Partners, the Wellmans

Pray: *O God, have mercy on us! Revive Your church that we may exercise a righteous influence in the world. Cause Your presence and power to be displayed in this church so that believers and unbelievers will be in awe of You. Do this, O God, for the sake of Your Son, who bought and established the church with His own blood! For the sake of Jesus and His love for the church, grant revival to Your people.*

THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Continue to pray for the needs associated with the coronavirus outbreak.

- Pray for those infected with the coronavirus to be healed.
- Pray for those grieving the loss of loved ones to be comforted and to look to Jesus.
- Ask God to give wisdom to world leaders to care for the sick and protect the people of their country.
- Pray for those working on a cure to stay healthy and find a cure.
- Pray for the economic needs of families, businesses, and the church.

FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Pray for LH homes to be places where disciple making happens, as we remain in our homes.

- Pray for LH moms and dads to share the hope of the Gospel in their home.
- Pray for LH homes to be filled with prayer, Bible study, laughter, and peace.
- Pray for LH to be trained in Three Big Things and the Disciple's Life so that disciples can make disciples.
- Pray that Jesus is honored in the homes of LH people.
- Pray that LH will care for neighbors and reach out to them to give help and hope.

SATURDAY: Pray for our worship gathering

This Sunday we begin a new 3-part series. It begins on Palm Sunday and continues through the Sunday after Easter. The series is entitled: **See the Greatness of God**

Title: God's Promise Made | Text: Zechariah 9:9/Matthew 21:1-8

Main Thrust: God promised that the Messiah would come humbly to save sinners. God kept that promise and on Palm Sunday, Jesus entered Jerusalem just as God promised He would. This promise was part of the grand plan of God to bring salvation to the world.

- Challenge people to believe the grand plan of God revealed in the entirety of the Bible: creation, fall, rescue, and restoration.
- Encourage people to believe in Jesus. He is the Savior of the world.

- Teach people how the coming of Jesus into Jerusalem points to the power of God to keep His promise and how this promise connects to all of the promises of God in the Bible.
- Help people to have in the power and goodness of God.
