DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray for the peace and welfare of our city and nation and that massive numbers of people would find spiritual peace by trusting in Christ.

Seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the Lord on its behalf, for in its welfare you will find your welfare. — Jer. 29:7

MONDAY: Global Impact Partners, Phillips Family (West Africa)

- Pray for the Phillips as they lead during these unique times. With no one being able to gather, they are trying to utilize social media more than ever before. However, one challenge they face is that a lot of their ministry is among people who don't have the ability to utilize these resources. Pray for the believers in the villages to continue to find ways to encourage one another and grow in their faith.
- Pray for Ayorou. Terrorist attacks are happening more and more frequently in and around Ayorou. Pray for Ibrahim as he leads the work in the region to be protected and to have wise faith as he ministers in such a devastated and dangerous area.
- Currently the Phillips have more of their missionaries in Great Bend in a place OUTSIDE their place of assignment than they do missionaries IN their place of assignment. Many were evacuated when Covid-19 began to hit hard. Pray for those not in their place of service to redeem the time.

TUESDAY: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

- Pray that everyone who comes into the Hope Center for Biblical Counseling and the Hope Center for Pregnancy will come to know more deeply and intimately the love of Christ that surpasses all knowledge and they are filled with the love of Christ. **Ephesians 3:14-21**
- Pray also for the counselors of the Hope Center for Biblical Counseling and the advocates in the Hope Center for Pregnancy. Pray they, too, will know the love of Christ more deeply and intimately. Pray they will continue to walk with the Lord, & they are strengthened through His spirit in their inner being & will remain rooted and established in the love of Christ. **Ephesians 3:14-21**

WEDNESDAY: Continued Revival in Living Hope

Focus your prayer around: **Jeremiah 33:3** "Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known."

Pray: *Father, You have declared in Your Word that if I call to You that You will show me great and mighty things which I do not know. I am calling to You, O God! I am pleading with You to grant revival to the believers of Living Hope. We desperately need it. You have the power to grant it. I am calling on You and am believing You for this. This is Your Word. I am calling to You, Father. Will You be true to Your Word? Are you going to be faithful to Your promise Father? For the sake of Your Word, I plead that You will grant revival to Your people.*

THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray for Kentucky and the USA as we all begin to prepare to re-enter work, church, and the world.

- Pray for leaders to have wisdom.
- Pray for people to be wise in keeping their hands clean and giving appropriate space.
- Pray for the virus not to spread.
- Pray for those working on a cure to stay healthy and find a cure.
- Pray for the people who are and who will get sick to be healed and keep their distance until they are healed.

FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Pray for LH to have, show, and share our faith in Jesus.

- Pray for LH members to be hopeful and share why they have hope in Jesus.
- Pray for LH members to know and share their 3-Part Testimony faithfully.
- Pray for LH members to care for their neighbors through prayer, encouragement, and by helping meet needs with kindness and compassion.
- Pray that Jesus is honored by the love shown by LH people.
- Pray that LH will be faithful in their tithes and offerings to enable the church to continue to care for the ministry of the church to our members, our city, and our world.

SATURDAY: Pray for our worship gathering

This Sunday we continue our series: **See the Celebrations of Life!**

Title: Graduation Is a Big Step | Text: Joshua 1:8-9

Main Thrust: Every season of life has its challenges by design. God has a plan for everything we go through. God calls His followers to go through each season with faith that produces strength and courage. Graduation is an important step into adulthood. It is a celebration of God's provision and a segue to the next season.

- Challenge people to trust and obey God in every season and to draw strength and courage from God's providential care and commands.
- Encourage people to know that what God commands is good. What God plans is best. What God expects is complete trust.
- Teach people how to look at each season and to identify what does not change (God's character and commands) and what does change (our circumstances).
- Help people see graduation as a great celebration from one season to the next, but God does not change what is needed for the next season - ant that is a faith that trusts and obeys God.
