DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

MONDAY: Local Impact

- **Pray for each other**

We, as followers of Jesus Christ, are the Local Impact missionaries of Bowling Green and Warren County. Let's pray for each other as we care for our families and neighbors. Let's pray for opportunities to share with others the hope that is found in the gospel of Jesus Christ. Let's pray that we each will live out the commission Jesus left for us to make disciples.

WEDNESDAY: Continued Revival in Living Hope

Focus your prayer around: **Ephesians 4:30** "And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption."

Pray: *Father, You have commanded in Your Word that we must not grieve the Holy Spirit. Yet, I confess that we have grieved Your Holy Spirit. He is grieved because of our sin and unwillingness to deal with that sin. I plead that You would grant revival so that we would deal with our sin as never before in our relationship to You. Do this so that Your Holy Spirit will no longer be grieved. Do this so that Your Holy Spirit will be pleased to release His power into our midst.*

THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Continue to pray for the needs associated with the coronavirus outbreak.

- Pray for those infected with the coronavirus to be healed.
- Pray for those grieving the loss of loved ones to be comforted and to look to Jesus.
- Ask God to give wisdom to world leaders to care for the sick and protect the people of their country.
- Pray for those working on a cure to stay healthy and find a cure.
- Pray for the economic needs of families, businesses, and the church.

FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Pray for LH homes to be places where disciple making happens, as we remain in our homes.

- Pray for LH moms and dads to share the hope of the Gospel in their home.
- Pray for LH homes to be filled with prayer, Bible study, laughter, and peace.
- Pray for LH to be trained in *Three Big Things* and the *Disciple's Life* so that disciples can make disciples.
- Pray that Jesus is honored in the homes of LH people.
- Pray that LH will care for neighbors and reach out to them to give help and hope.

SATURDAY: Pray for our worship gathering

This Sunday we celebrate Easter in a way few of us ever have. We continue the series is entitled: **See the Greatness of God!**

Title: God's Promise Kept | Text: Luke 24:44-47

Main Thrust: The Bible is about Jesus. It tells the story of God's work in the world to save a people for Himself. After Jesus was raised, He spelled out God's rescue plan for all to know and believe. God's promise to save has been kept!

- Challenge people to believe in God's rescue plan – Jesus – and to make disciples of Jesus.
- Encourage people to know that God's promise has been kept.
- Teach people what the Bible says about God's rescue plan and what this promise kept accomplishes.
- Help people honor Jesus by believing in Him and sharing His salvation with the world.
