### DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that God would provide opportunities for the Gospel to penetrate unreached people groups and also Gospel aware, but disinterested people in our city.

At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ. — Col. 4:3

### MONDAY: Local Impact Partners

Bryan Lewis (Hope House)

- Pray that Hope House ministries will continue to trust the Lord during a time of great financial burden.
- Pray that their staff will be unified and continue serving the community during this time of isolation.

Daniel & Alice Tarnagda (Refuge BG)

- Pray for Daniel and Alice Tarnagda's health as they interact with refugees that have tested COVID-19 positive.
- Pray that Alice and Daniel would allow God to work through them as they have gospel conversations with refugees. Pray that they would see those individuals come to Christ.

Collin Wood (WKU BCM on campus ministry, International Students)

- Pray for Collin and Sarah as they adjust to a new baby boy.
- Please pray that the Lord would fill them up with energy, and continually use them to advance His kingdom.

Tim Stover (WKU CRU on campus ministry, Bridges International Students)

- Pray the Lord would continue opening avenues for Tim to share the gospel with international students despite COVID-19.
- Pray that Tim would walk through doors the Lord opens to bring international students to WKU next semester.

### WEDNESDAY: Continued Revival in Living Hope

Focus your prayer around: **Jeremiah 33:3** "Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known."

**Pray:** *Father, You have declared in Your Word that if I call to You that You will show me great and mighty things which I do not know. I am calling to You, O God! I am pleading with You to grant revival to the believers of Living Hope. We desperately need it. You have the power to grant it. I am calling on You and am believing You for this. This is Your Word. I am calling to You, Father. Will You be true to Your Word? Are you going to be faithful to Your promise Father? For the sake of Your Word, I plead that You will grant revival to Your people.*

### THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray for God's people to be peacemakers in the midst of so much social and political unrest.

- Pray for God's people to be inspired and driven by God's love in all that they think, say, and do.
- Pray for God's people to show love to those who are hurting, and grace and forgiveness to those who are causing hurt.
- Pray God's people refuse to allow any bitterness, anger, or hatred to exist in their hearts, but instead, give love and grace to all people as God has given love and grace to us.
- Pray for God's people to avoid being critical or disparaging of others. Pray they seek the good where it can be found. Pray they speak enthusiastically in the power of the Holy Spirit and the love of God revealed in the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

### FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

Pray for LH to be good neighbors who show and regularly speak of the love of God in the Gospel.

- Pray for LH member to shine as models of love and grace.
- Pray for LH members to speak to the reason they have hope.
- Pray for LH members to talk about God's love revealed in Jesus.
- Pray that LH members will share the 3Circles to help explain the brokenness of our world, rather than joining in the clamor of voices blaming politicians and human systems. The problem of humanity is sin and only Jesus can deal with sin and heal humanity.

### SATURDAY: Pray for our worship gathering

This Sunday we continue our new series for the summer: **See the Need for Love!**

**Title: Love Your Neighbors | Text: Matthew 22:37-40**

**Main Thrust:** God made us to love Him and love each other. When sin entered the world, our hearts were broken and our relationships became complicated. The only cure for us is love.

- Challenge people to love God in response to the gracious, redeeming love He has given to us.
- Encourage people to love others with the love God has given to us and to love them as we love ourselves. Love dares to put ourselves in other's shoes and love them the way we'd want to be loved, if we had thought, felt, and lived in their shoes.
- Teach people how love keeps the 10 Commandments.
- Help people see the benefit of love and to seek the blessing only love gives.
